Window heat pumps, "Thru-the-wall" heat pumps (hotel-type machines) and Ductless Mini-Split Heat Pumps when only used for sunrooms, room additions or other small areas.

PLEASE NOTE:

Your electric cooperative reserves the right to approve, deny or select the appropriate incentive. Prior approval from your electric co-op is required for electric resistance incentives.

To qualify, the home in which the equipment is installed must be occupied year-round (12 months) and an energy management switch must be installed on rebated equipment.

To receive an incentive from your cooperative, homeowners must provide AHRI (Air conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute) validation for all SEER ratings. This can be obtained from the installing heating and cooling dealer. No incentive will be awarded based on SEER rating listed on the HVAC dealer bid specifications, promotional material of dealer, manufacturer or any other source than AHRI.

Homeowners must complete a request form and provide proof of purchase (invoice or receipt) to receive any 2020 incentive.

Deadline to apply for 2020 Rebate Program is Dec. 18, 2020

No rebate will be awarded based on HVAC dealer bid specifications, promotional material of dealer, manufacturer or any other source than AHRI. A certificate of AHRI-certified performance must be submitted.

All homeowners must complete a rebate request form and provide proof of purchase to receive any 2020 rebate. Deadline to apply for 2020 Rebate Program is Dec. 18, 2020.

All homeowners and future homeowners receiving rebates from the electric cooperative agree to the future installation of an energy management switch on these rebated appliances to allow future peak demand energy management procedures. The cooperative reserves the right to approve, deny or select the appropriate rebate. The co-op also reserves the right to inspect and verify installation of equipment receiving a rebate.
