Chrisney Volunteer Fire Department - \$1,500 (asked for \$3,220)

To purchase Wildland Fire Resistant Boots.

Anderson Twp. Volunteer Fire Department - \$2,840 (asked for \$4,740)

To purchase On-Spot Chains \$2,840 (also asked for Whelen Light Bar \$1,200, and Rear LED Beacons \$700).

Central Perry Volunteer Fire Department - \$1,000 (asked for \$1,972)

To purchase 4 kenwood portable radios with chargers, speaker mics, and batteries.
